Attendance and Lateness

Our current school attendance is 94%. Government guidelines say that attendance is good if it is above 96%. External classroom doors will open 5 minutes before the allocated start time and will close 5 minutes after the allocated start time. Any child arriving after this time is classed as late.

Well done to Reception Red, Red 1, Yellow 1 and Blue 5 who have all won our trophy for the best attendance over a week. Particularly well done to Yellow 3 who have won the attendance trophy 3 times!

Gold certificates have also been given out to children who have not had any time off school last half term. Children with attendance above 96% have received a silver certificate and those with attendance above 90% have a bronze certificate.

Please encourage your children to come to school as much as possible and make sure that they are on time.
